

2010 Pacific Grove Feast of Lanterns Royal Court Application Instructions

To apply for a position on the Royal Court, you must complete a Royal Court Application Form and Checklist (Application) signed by you and your parent(s) or guardian(s). In addition to the completed Application, you must include the following with the Application:

1. **A short, original essay** that introduces you to the interview panel. It may include information about your family, academic achievements, interests, community service or other successes. Information in the essay may be used in Feast of Lanterns publications or in personal introductions at Feast of Lanterns events. The essay should be less than 1,000 words.
2. **Two letters of personal reference** from adults in the community who know you and understand the commitment and responsibilities expected of young women who serve on the Royal Court. One must be from a teacher with whom you currently interact or interacted in the recent past. The other must be an adult community member who knows you, such as a church leader, employer, mentor or other non-family friend. The letters should describe your character and why they believe you would be an asset to the Feast of Lanterns and represent the City of Pacific Grove well.
3. **A current photo** of yourself.
4. **Complete the Checklists** that are included on the reverse of the Application. One is for you to complete, and the other for your parent or guardian to complete. By initialing next to each statement you and your parent or guardian signify you have completed the assignment and you understand the requirements of the application process and the responsibilities and commitment serving on the Royal Court requires.
5. **Submit the completed Application with attachments** by 4:00 pm, Friday February 26, 2010. You may:

6. **Prepare for your personal interview** before a panel of five community members. The panel may ask you questions about the history of the Feast of Lanterns and why you want to serve on the Royal Court in addition to your community service, academics, extracurricular activities, and other responsibilities you hold. The panel will score your responses using a point system. You will also be scored on your appearance and grooming, poise, and written and verbal communication skills.
